- Are there any restrictions on backwashing or chemical cleans due to limitations at the wastewater treatment plant?
- Do you have enough chemicals on hand for 2-4 weeks? (i.e. coagulant, pH adjustment, chlorine, corrosion control, etc.)
- Do you have back up parts for chemical feed pumps and online monitoring equipment?
- Can the plant function if computer systems are inoperable?
- Do you have materials for turbidimeter calibrations, or have you verified that your contracted company will still come out and do them?
